The Pastor's Corner

We changed some of our schedules this month to serve you better. First of all, with additional priests, we added one Mass on Monday mornings at 7:30 A.M. Previously this had been a Word Service with Communion.

We also added an extra half-hour of time to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation with our parishioners. We now will hear "Confessions" from 3:00 P.M. until 4:00 P.M. on Saturday afternoons. We have had an increase in the number of confessions recently, and want to serve you better. However, please come during the hour allotted for confessions. It seems some have developed a bad habit of coming just before Mass at 4 p.m. and expecting the celebrant to "hear their confession." This causes the celebrant to feel hurried and unprepared to celebrate the Holy Eucharist properly. With your cooperation, we will celebrate Reconciliation only during this hour, ending at 4:00 p.m. (and at other times by appointment).

I trust you know that one of the major prayers of the Church is Lectio Divino (The Divine Office). It ranks high with the celebration of the Eucharist. Many parishes now celebrate Morning Prayer (part of the Divine Office) either prior to or following morning Masses. The clergy of our parish are interested in beginning this practice here, praying Morning Prayer with our parishioners. If you are interested, we likely will provide the necessary prayer books for this (to remain in the church) and will pray this at 7:15 A.M. prior to weekday morning Masses.

Think about this prayer, and consider this an invitation to enter into an even deeper prayer life with the church. I will mention this to our weekday morning worshippers. If you are interested, I will let you know when we will begin this. The Office will be in addition to the regular weekday morning Masses, not in place of it.

15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

In our religious special education classes this past year, we discussed miracles with the kids. But before the year began, each of us catechists was given a "miracle box," a simple wooden box with an inscription on top, asking us to look deeper-to look deeper at our kids with special needs, for in them we would find the miracle of God’s true love, a love given freely to the innocent and shared with us.



Jesus’ parables are widely known, and most of us can recall them in some detail. But often, we fail to look deeper into their meaning and accept the challenge to apply them to our own lives. As with the parable of the sower and the seed, do we listen to God’s word at Mass or are we distracted or un-interested? How many of us can actually recall the readings or the pastor’s homily even a few hours after we hear them?

Today, please accept the challenge of looking deeper into the word of God. The Catechism of the Catholic Church advises we meditate; this is an opportunity to quiet ourselves to the noise of the world and listen to each and every word given to us (CCC 2707). The beauty of Jesus’ parables is that although they are short and to the point, they can have a different meaning to each of us, and can truly be life-changing. Look deeper.
